**Sister Marie Kevin Mueller, SSND,  
Notre Dame Prep music teacher, 89**

Sister Marie Kevin Mueller, a longtime music teacher at Notre Dame Preparatory School and a local community leader within her congregation, died of heart failure on Oct. 18 at Maria Health Care Center in Baltimore. She was 89 years old and had been a professed member of the School Sisters of Notre Dame for 68 years.

Moira Joseph Mueller was born in Baltimore on March 24, 1922, the oldest of five children, to H. Gerard and Mary Frances (Macky) Mueller. She grew up in Our Lady of Mount Carmel parish and graduated from the Institute of Notre Dame in 1940. Later that summer she entered the School Sisters of Notre Dame. She was given the religious name Marie Kevin and made her first vows in August 1943.

In an early autobiography, Sister Marie Kevin recalled in second grade. "From the very first day I touched the believed music came easily to her because family mem inclined. In high school she added studies in organ and was always her forte. "I try to realize the talent which I wrote. "He only lent it to me for these years on earth, a give it with my whole heart."

In 1958, Sister Marie Kevin returned to Baltimore and year ministry at Notre Dame Preparatory School (1958 Dame Prep convent, she spent 11 years as superior, or Hampton.

In 1995, Sister Kevin moved to Villa Assumpta and took on the assignment of heritage coordinator for the former Baltimore Province. She remained in that ministry until retiring to prayer and presence in 2008.



Sister Marie Kevin earned a bachelor's degree in music from the Catholic University of America in 1948. In 1962, she earned a master's in music education from the same university.

A Mass of Christian burial was celebrated at the chapel at Villa Assumpta in Baltimore on Oct. 25 by the Rev. Kevin Anthony Mueller, Sister Marie Kevin's nephew.

Sister Marie Kevin is survived by a sister, Adelaide Besche, and a brother, Joseph Carroll Mueller, both of the Baltimore area, and nieces and nephews.
