Board Roles in an SSND Sponsored Ministry

This on-site workshop is designed for a joint meeting of board members, corporate members, and administrators. Using the definition of SSND sponsorship as a framework, participants will review the relationship between an organization and School Sisters of Notre Dame, as well as the defining characteristics of a sponsored ministry. The roles of board members, corporate members, and administrators will be discussed, and the meaning of “reserved powers” in a two-tier board structure will be examined.

Participants will also have the opportunity to consider their particular school or organization in terms of the “defining characteristics,” enabling them to assess their organization’s readiness to begin their SSND Sponsorship Review process.

Minimum amount of time required is two hours.

This workshop will be conducted by Sister Grace D’Amico, SSND, NAMA Sponsorship Coordinator, and may be held on either a weekday or a weekend. Minimum number of participants is 10.

No fee will be charged by the NAMA Sponsorship Office. Arrangements must be made at least six weeks in advance. Last date available is June 19, 2010.
