### Board Workshop

## Sponsorship: Gift and Challenge

This workshop, given on-site, is designed as a board retreat day, and may include administrators, key staff members, and provincial council liaisons of the SSND school or organization.

The first part, “Gift” will acquaint the participants with the definition and meaning of SSND sponsorship, the defining characteristics of an SSND sponsored ministry, and an overview of SSND sponsored schools and outreach ministries in the United States, Guam, and Africa.

The second part, “Challenge,” will introduce the participants to three “lenses” through which their own school or organization can be viewed:

- ❖ Fidelity to SSND Vision
- ❖ Viability as an Organization
- ❖ Sustainability as an *SSND* Ministry

Participants will be helped to determine which of these areas require attention in their own school or organization. Results will provide valuable input for strategic planning and goal setting processes.

This day long workshop will be conducted by Sister Grace D’Amico, SSND, NAMA Sponsorship Coordinator, and may be held on either a weekday or a weekend. Minimum number of participants is 10.
